



Marina Pez Vela is open for business!

It's not easy to improve on one of the most spectacular sport fishing locations on the planet but the new **Marina Pez Vela** in Quepos, Costa Rica is doing just that.

Designed as a full-service marina complete with five-star amenities, Pez Vela will be the largest marina in Costa Rica with over 300 wet slips and the capability of handling vessels up to 200 feet in length. Additionally, a four tiered dry-slip storage facility for another 120 boats of up to 35 feet in length will be in place to accommodate seasonal residents who wish to keep their boats at the ready.

Marina Pez Vela will feature the only truly full-service boatyard for nearly 1,000 miles of coastline and have the capacity to handle vessels up to 130 feet in a yard that will be serviced by Marine Travel lifts with capacities of 75 tons and 200 tons.

Not only will the Boatyard at Marina Pez Vela have exceptional in-house service capabilities, but they will also provide a mix of service vendors on-site offering specialty services one would expect from a quality marina and boatyard. Vendors will provide

such services as:

- Air conditioning service and repair
- Electronic service and repair
- Canvas service and repair
- Propeller shop
- Hydraulics service

The first phase of Pez Vela's construction has been completed with the first 100 slips being delivered and the fuel dock and marine store now open. The second phase of construction which will include the remaining 200 wet-slips, dry-slip storage and the boatyard is set to begin mid-2011.

Just a 20 minute drive from Hacienda Matapalo, the coastal town of Quepos has long been regarded as the fishing capital of Costa Rica with 41 world record catches. Now with the opening of what is undoubtedly the premiere marina in Central America, Quepos is undergoing a renaissance that includes new municipal infrastructure projects and private sector construction that will serve visiting fishermen and yachting enthusiasts from around the world.
